Annotation

The international scientific conference of the **20 years with the EU** will take place on the occasion of the 20th anniversary of the accession of the countries of Central Europe, specifically the countries of the Visegrad Group, to the European Union. On May 1, 2004, exactly twenty years ago, the largest enlargement of the European Union in its history took place. States that were undergoing a demanding economic and social transformation became members of the EU. They had to adapt to the conditions imposed by the most economically advanced states of Europe, as a result of which these countries gave up many of their economic and social goods. Adaptation of legal and political systems was also required, in exchange for the possibility of free movement of people, goods, services and capital, and for the promise to become part of the club of the richest countries in the world. To this day, there are extensive discussions about the positives and negatives of this step.

The goal of the international conference is to analyse the consequences of EU membership, with the key question being how membership has changed the V4 states. The ambition of the conference is to provide scientists, practitioners, doctoral students, students, as well as the public, with a space for professional discussion, a platform for the exchange of experiences, evaluations, analyses and reflections on the use or non-use of the opportunity offered by the entry into the EU to the V4 states. A space to discuss how the EU has changed, to raise questions about its future functioning, the influence of the V4 states on its decision-making processes, etc.

Last but not least, the intention of the conference is to enable partners to meet and provide the opportunity and conditions for informal conversations and negotiations, which always strengthens academic cooperation.

- 5. The author receives a decision on the final acceptance or rejection of the article
- 6. Accepted articles will be processed by the editorial board of the conference and published in a collection or journal

PATTERN

Sample use of bibliographic references

The designation of the bibliographic reference (citation, paraphrase) is always written at the place where the author refers to the used bibliographic reference. A citation (paraphrase) is used to connect a given place with a record of the cited document. This entry is part of the bibliographic reference list at the end of the document. In the text, you can use comments that are placed in a footnote. The text of the citation is stated directly in the text, or paraphrase and after it in the case of "citation" (Katuščák, 1998, p. 87) or paraphrase (Katuščák, 1998). Works by the same author published in the same year are distinguished when citing by indicating the year of publication with a lowercase letter (Katuščák, 1998a, p. 87), or (Katuščák, 1998b, p. 90). In the bibliography, this designation will be preserved. In the case of citations, when the author is not identifiable, e.g. quoting information from internet sites or journals, weeklies, etc., the beginning of the title of the article is indicated so that it is clearly identifiable in the list of bibliographic references (First Steps: A Manual..., 1996). Documents are presented in full (Universal Declaration of Human Rights, 1948), the source from which the document was drawn is indicated in the list of bibliographic references.


Graph 1Počet vybavených cestujúcich na Letisku Žilina (2000 – 2011)
